Author and Recording Artist Judy Jacobs Encourages Others to Follow Their Dreams at Any Age

Don't Miss Your Moment is a book about experiencing life's best moments

Chattanooga, TN – According to recording artist and mentoring advocate Judy Jacobs, many people are unaware that there are still opportunities to grab on to life's biggest moments and pursue their passion. In *Don't Miss Your Moment: It's Never Too Late to Live Your Best* (Strang Communications), Jacobs takes readers through the journey of discovering their calling, and includes practical wisdom for applying Jacobs' teachings.

"A moment is when a divine spark catches in your life—it involves decisions that include your career, residence, relationships or your leisure activities," Jacobs says. She stresses that it's not a national spotlight or large audiences that define importance—everyone has a unique calling. "God calls people who are willing to push hard. He knows that if you can take it, you can make it." Jacobs says. "Don't settle for an existence instead of a life."

Jacobs, whose heritage is rooted in the Native American Indian Lumbee Tribe, a group that fought vigorously for its civil rights of equality and freedom, shares stories from her life. Once the shy, daughter of a sharecropper with 11 siblings who grew up in the church, Jacobs has become an accomplished singer and a speaker to thousands of people around the world.

From the day of Pentecost, to the Valley of Dry Bones in Ezekiel, *Don't Miss Your Moment* draws out scriptural teachings and insight into relevant topics, including:

- Identifying a "moment" and experiencing God's calling
- Recapturing lost moments, waiting on and pursuing your moment
- Biblical examples of people who captured or missed their moments
- Understanding the importance of mentoring in your purpose

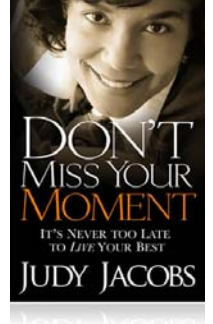
According to Jacobs, Christians should be expecting the unexpected. "Your whole life is going to be a series of God moments that build on each other. You belong to God, so expect it," Jacobs says. "It's deadly serious business to make the wrong choice and miss your moment. It can be costly."

Jacobs' personal passion is found in her International Institute of Mentoring, where she trains church ministry leaders and those starting schools, churches and orphanages. In 2008, Jacobs expanded her philanthropic calling when she became part of a humanitarian effort to provide clothing to orphanages around the world and Native American children within the United States.

Judy Jacobs is a recording artist, ordained minister, teacher and sought-after conference speaker. She is the host of the television program *Judy Jacobs Now!*, which airs on major Christian networks, as well as the yearly "Press, Push, and Pursue" conferences at various locations worldwide.
