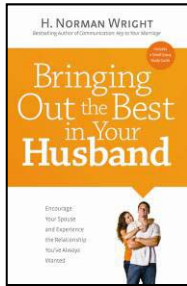

7. Sometimes when a husband acts out, it actually indicates that they are very discouraged. What are some signs that your husband may need a little extra encouragement from his wife?
