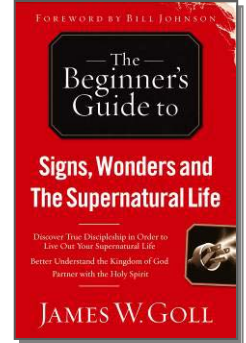

Living Your God-Given Spiritual Life

Author Holds on to Promise of the Holy Spirit and Kingdom of God Principles Through Personal Health Battle and Wife's Death to Cancer.

Nashville, TN: Living a supernatural life has become a tainted idea for many Christians. As people of faith daily battle a spiritual war between good and evil, the Bible assures Christians of a victorious outcome, yet many believers who claim to live with a supernatural God inside of them still live in a fear, doubt, ignorance and division on how to fully experience a supernatural, spirit-filled life.

James Goll, Director of Prayer Storm and the Coordinator of Encounters Alliance, has released ***The Beginner's Guide to Signs, Wonders and the Supernatural Life*** (Regal Books) as an introduction to the internal and external changes believers can expect when they choose to follow Christ.



Goll reminds Christians that supernatural living is not only about miracles, healings and other supernatural manifestations, but consists largely of discipleship, growth in godly character traits and obedience to the will of God. “The work of Jesus Christ on the cross has made it possible for all believers in Christ to walk in the supernatural and receive His righteousness and enter into fellowship and favor with God,” says Goll. “By acknowledging the power of the cross and the power of the blood that was shed there, we can defeat the devil and freely step into the Kingdom.”

Goll's faith in the supernatural life was tested through some of his greatest pain including his grueling 8 year battle with non-Hodgkin's lymphoma cancer and the death of his wife to cancer in 2008. While many might question God or become embittered toward Him during life's greatest adversities, Goll embraced extraordinary courage and faith through the Holy Spirit. ***The Beginner's Guide to Signs, Wonders and the Supernatural Life*** will assist Christians in a greater understanding of the following:

- How to Relate to the Holy Spirit through Positive and Negative Responses
- The Importance of Listening, Watching and Waiting in the Supernatural Life
- Practical Ways to Increase the Anointing of the Spirit

Goll also believes that the quality of your supernatural life is dependent on your spiritual growth in Christ. “Living a crucified life has got to be supernatural, because everything within my human flesh objects to self-sacrifice. Walking in the supernatural life, you will be clothed with love, purity, holiness, tenderheartedness, mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience, endurance and more. These will come from deep within you, where the Holy Spirit resides,” says Goll.

As the newest addition to the popular *Beginner's Guide* series, this practical, easy-to-follow guide helps Christians understand how their character is reshaped to conform to Christ's image, dependent on the Holy Spirit, as God works through them to accomplish miracles. Readers will find a well-rounded overview of what to expect as citizens in the supernatural kingdom of God. In addition, they will learn to identify the supernatural work of the kingdom of darkness, to battle against the evil one's falsehoods and to live daily in the Holy Spirit's power.

"Each time you treat someone with love, exercise a spiritual gift, surrender to the lordship of Jesus, seek guidance from God - not to mention each time you pray for (and receive) a miracle or achieve a victory over the power of darkness - you are living the supernatural life that Jesus won for you. Through you, the kingdom of God is making inroads into the kingdom of darkness."

"A believer who desires to be filled with the Spirit must only meet certain very basic conditions:

1. Believe that it is God's promise for you today (see Acts 2:39).
2. Prepare your heart through repentance (see Acts 2:38).
3. Ask (See Luke 11:13).
4. Have faith to receive (See John 7:38-39; Gal. 3:2)."

"There are no shortcuts to the supernatural life because there are no shortcuts to discipleship. And the supernatural life, after all, is a life of discipleship. Remember what Jesus said: 'He who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me. He who finds his life will lose it, and he who loses his life for My sake will find it' (Matt. 10:38-39, NKJV). If you want to live a supernatural life, take a deep breath, bend down low and pick up your cross."

"God has exalted His Word above even His own name (see Ps. 138:2). As God's children, we need to exalt His Word and make it priority in our lives. By putting the Word first in your life, you will experience far more of God's supernatural life and blessing. The Word is full of God's life and power. If you will meditate on it and plant it in your heart, mixing it with active faith in the Living Word, you will begin to experience life and power in a fuller and fuller measure."

"To walk in increased anointing, you will definitely need *patience*. This is the virtue that none of us wants but all of us need. You will also need a supernatural supply of *compassion*, which characterizes everything God does. Ask Him for more of His heart toward the people around you. Ask for more of His mercy, brokenness and humility. As you receive more of His heart, you will also receive a greater measure of His anointing."

"Supernatural life is faith working through love. It is the love of God that keeps me going. It is the love of God that helps me to never quit. It is the love of God that causes me to believe in the reality of the supernatural life when I haven't seen it all manifested yet. Love is supernatural. Without God, who is love, anything we might think is love is a mere shadow of the real thing (see 1 John 4:8)."

"The supernatural life is like a seamless garment woven on the loom of God's love. Once you put it on, you need to take care of it so that it will last as long as you do. It can be cleaned and repaired as needed, but when the time comes for you to go Home, you will want to have it on so that you can exchange it for a pure white robe. Stay close to the One who gave it to you so that at the end, you can finish well, having remained in love with the Giver of supernatural life right up until you draw your last breath on earth."
