

- Questions about the Bible: Why are there different versions of the Bible, and which one should I use? Are dinosaurs in the Bible? Why do some books have different details about the same stories? Why does the Bible say God changed his mind but also says he does not?
- Questions about God and the Holy Spirit: What does it mean to test God? Did God create sin? Why was there slavery in biblical times? Can Christians lose the Holy Spirit? Will we see the Holy Spirit in heaven? What does it mean to quench the Spirit?
- Questions about Jesus and salvation: Did Jesus predict his own death? Where was Jesus for the three days between his death and resurrection? How do you discuss hell and a loving God? Do infants who die go to heaven? Why is baptism important? Can a Christian's name be erased from the Book of Life?
- Questions about church, family life, and Christian living: How are children a blessing from the Lord? What does it mean to be a godly parent? Should Christians fast? Is premarital sex, gambling, or drinking alcohol a sin? What does the Bible teach about tithing?
- Questions about worldviews and end times: What does the Bible teach about social justice? Can you be pro-life and support the death penalty? What happens after we die? Do pets go to heaven when they die? Are we living in the last days? What are the new heavens and earth?

Alex and Bert acknowledge that the Bible doesn't have direct answers for all the questions we may have about Christian life today, but we can trust that God is infallible. He inspired the writers of the Bible to give us the principles we need to live the truth. They intentially support their answers with an abundance of Scripture to show its authority and to encourage people to read the passages, take notes, and meditate on the Word for personal and spiritual growth.
