

The Chosen novels, like many books and films about Jesus, feature biblical and historical elements that offer a more realistic depiction of Jesus, his disciples, and their ministry.



It is the highest crowdfunded project, having raised over \$20 million and has garnered more than 400 million views, prompting its translation into over 50 languages.
